Those 20 along with Council, Sister City committee members, City staff, and general public will more than satisfy the request to have 20 to participate in the tea ceremony that will open the welcome reception. Tables will be set up to accommodate the products the S'land businesses have brought as potential for trade exchange.

<u>Farewell Party</u> Thursday, October 9<sup>th</sup> between 6:00-9:00 p.m. at Rec Centre Banquet Room. Lorrie Forde to MC. Two wineries confirmed to be set up for mini wine festival/tasting. They are Okanagan Crush Pad and Saxon Winery. They will pour tastings and glasses to accompany the meal. Wineries will keep track of the number of glasses they pour. We will pay for the bottles used to fill glasses and the wineries will donate the wine for the tastings. Still looking for two more children for the fashion show. (Discussion

resulted in options for this need). All others are in place for entertainment and fashion show. Reserved seating for delegates, host families, and committee members. Two RCMP confirmed to march in with delegation at 6:00 pm. Still waiting to hear whether there is a piper to lead the procession. Fashion show models will have been dressed at 5:00 pm and they will march in with the delegation. Sawako to confirm with Mrs. Sato once she is here but for now the plan is to have the models for the fashion show sit on chairs near stage when the delegation marches in. Delegates to be welcomed at their tables and host families to make sure their guest is taken up for wine tasting and to get a glass to have with their dinner.

Delegates and committee members invited to attend.

  - 1) Host families Meeting was held with all host families. No concerns. Discussion about helping out one host family with some driving challenges. Arrangements to accommodate confirmed.
