CURRENT PRE-AUTHORIZED PAYMENT PLAN CUSTOMERS

If you are currently enrolled in the prepayment plan, remember to pay the final payment amount and claim your HOG if eligible. You will be notified in early August of your new prepayment amount based on an estimate of your 2018 taxes.

DON'T FORGET

The Home Owner Grant (HOG) Application must be completed each and every year you are eligible to receive it. A mortgage company cannot do this on your behalf. An unclaimed HOG is subject to a 10% penalty. For more information or to claim the Home Owner Grant online, please visit the front page of our website www.summerland.ca or call for assistance.

All payments and Home Owner Grant (HOG) applications (if applicable) must be received at Municipal Hall by 4:00pm Friday, July 7th, 2017 to prevent a 10% penalty on the unpaid balance.

PAYING YOUR PROPERTY TAXES AND CLAIMING THE HOG

Pay in Person at Municipal Hall - Come in anytime before the due date, bring in your HOG (if applicable) and pay our cashier at Municipal Hall, 13211 Henry Ave. We accept cash, cheque, Interac/debit, money orders or **post-dated cheques** payable to the District of Summerland. **Credit cards are not accepted.** If possible, please have the grant application located at the bottom of your tax notice completed and payment ready when you bring it in.

Drop Box - Payments and HOGs can be put in our Drop Box (located to the left of Municipal Hall's front entrance). Please write your roll number on your cheque.

Pay by Mail - Send payments along with your HOG (if applicable) to District of Summerland, Box 159, 13211 Henry Avenue, Summerland, BC V0H 1Z0. **Post marks are NOT considered as the date of payment**. Mail post-dated cheques early to avoid being late.

<u>Claim the Home Owner Grant Online</u>– You will need your roll number and access code (found at the top right of your notice) to claim your HOG online. Visit our website www.summerland.ca and click on the Property Tax information found on the front page. Don't forget to print your receipt!

<u>Internet or Telephone Banking Through your Financial Institution</u> - Search for Summerland, Corporation or District of Summerland (taxes) as a payee and use your roll number as the account number. Try your roll number without the decimal and if that does not work, try it with the decimal, with the 325 in front and with out the 325 in front (every bank is different). If you still have difficulties, call your financial institution.

<u>Pay at your Financial Institution</u> - Most institutions will accept Property Tax Payments. Please note, the District is not responsible for errors made or late payments received from financial institutions.

<u>Paid by the Mortgage Company</u> - If your Mortgage Company pays your taxes on your behalf, please ensure you still complete and send in the Home Owner Grant Application (if eligible). A Mortgage Code (top right of your notice) will be indicated. The District is not responsible for errors made by mortgage providers.

<u>Pre-Authorized Prepayment Plan -</u> This program offers a convenient way to prepay for your property taxes in monthly installments. Application forms are available at Municipal Hall or on our website <u>www.summerland.ca.</u> Sign up now to make next year's payment easier!

YOU MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO DEFER YOUR PROPERTY TAXES

The Property Tax Deferment Program is a provincial program and offers deferral options to taxpayers who are age 55 & older, a surviving spouse, a person with a disability or families with children.
