

SUMMER STUDENTS – Parks (6) and Works & Infrastructure (2)

Join us for the summer!

The District of Summerland is hiring students for both our parks and Works & Infrastructure departments for the period of May 1 to September 1, 40 hours per week, to assist in the maintenance of our parks, roads and beaches. To be eligible for this excellent opportunity, students must have attended secondary school, college or university during the last school term and be returning to studies in the subsequent year or be completing their schooling in the same year.

What's in it for you?

- This is a union (CUPE) position with an hourly rate of \$21.64 per hour plus an additional 14% in lieu (\$24.67 per hour) increased to \$22.08 plus 14% (\$25.17 per hour) on June 29.
- A premium of \$0.50 per hour will be paid to returning students.
- Students will be trained and supervised by District staff who have various areas of expertise and technical knowledge.

Competition 24-04 – Works & Infrastructure (Roads)

 Roads operations include maintenance of municipal streets, lanes, boulevards, cemeteries, sidewalks and drainage systems, and other duties as required.

Competition 24-06 – Parks

 Parks operations include maintenance of green spaces, gardens, boulevards, playing fields, parks, playgrounds, washroom facilities, garbage collection and other duties as required.
