



### CAO Report – March 3, 2025

Spring is in the air, and crews are out and about getting things cleaned up. Potholes are appearing and we are starting to patch those with a temporary cold mix asphalt formula while we wait for the hot mix plant to start up. Street sweeping is also beginning soon and given the number of roads throughout the district it will take about two months. The Prairie Valley Road project from Cartwright to Morrow is also going to be starting up again which will include a new watermain, reconstruction of the roadway, and new multi-use pathway and other infrastructure. The exact date of the startup is weather-dependent but please keep an eye out for detours signs once things get going, and then please keep an eye out for workers and equipment in the area.

We have also been communicating on the website, Facebook and the newsletter about changes taking place at the landfill in the way we handle materials that potentially contain asbestos. These changes align with WorkSafe BC's objectives and our safe procedures to protect workers and the community from asbestos exposure. Please check out the website for more information.
