The District of Summerland is currently recruiting for community members to get involved in local government by participating in the following committee:

Agriculture Advisory Committee (AAC) Nine (9) positions are available for a two (2) year term, ending March 31, 2027:

The AAC advises and makes recommendations to Council on policies, procedures and bylaws that affect the agricultural community and impact agricultural viability within the District of Summerland.

Community Climate Action Advisory Committee (CCAAC) Seven (7) positions available for a two (2) year term, ending March 31, 2027:

The CCAAC advises and makes recommendations to Council on policies, procedures and bylaws that impact the District's sustainability efforts.

Development Process Improvement Advisory Committee (DPIAC) Nine (9) positions available for a two (2) year term, ending March 31, 2027:

The DPIAC mandate is to provide advice and assistance to Council and staff as the Development Services Department look to update bylaws, processes, and procedures as they relate to planning, development, and construction in the community.

Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee (PRAC) Seven (7) positions available for a two (2) year term, ending March 31, 2027:

The PRAC advises and makes recommendations to Council by providing a local perspective on the provision of the parks and recreation services, programs and facilities in Summerland.

Advisory Planning Commission (APC) Eight (8) positions available for a three (3) year term:

This commission shall assist Council in an advisory capacity on the following applications:

Amendments to the Official Community Plan, Amendments to the Zoning Bylaw, and other requests that may be referred to them by Council. This group consists of the public at large and their decisions are based on the information provided to them from the Planner and other sources. The commission does not meet on a regular schedule, instead holding meetings when there are items to be considered.
