Welcome to Peach Orchard Campground, the following rules and regulations are meant to ensure a safe, peaceful, and content vacation for your family and your camping neighbor. The failure of you or any member of your family/group to comply with these rules may result in eviction.

- Check-in time is no earlier than 2 P.M. and no later than 11 P.M. If you arrive after office hours, please proceed to your assigned site and see check in the following morning. If guests wish to stay an extra night, please check with the office by 10 am for approval or payment or book on-line.
- Check out is not later than 11 A.M. Late check-outs without approval and payment will result in additional fees and towing fees if necessary.
- **Gates close** between 11 p.m. and 7 a.m. Gates will only be open for medical emergencies.
- **Visitors** must register at the office before entering the campground. Visitors' vehicles must be left in overflow parking and walk in.
- Only occupy your designated site. An empty site does not mean there is not a reservation coming into that site. You may not use it to park your vehicle or any other reason.
- **Quiet Time** is enforced from 11 p.m. to 8 a.m. Please keep you noise level to a minimum and in your designated site after 11 p.m.
- No Parties, music or visitors between 11 p.m. And 8 a.m.
- Public drunkenness/disorderly behavior at any time on the campground property may result in immediate eviction and if necessary, contact the RCMP.
- Due to the proximity of sites, it is requested that cannabis use be consumed off premises to not impact your neighbors.
- **Children** must be supervised in the campground. Injuries and damage caused from lack of supervision is not the responsibility of the campground. All children under 16 must be on their site by 11 p.m.
- Nails and ropes are <u>not</u> permitted to be used in trees.

- Maximum 2 dogs per site. Dogs must never be left alone or unattended at your site, especially in an RV. The small, enclosed area of your camper is easily subjected to temperature swings and if your breaker fails due to the high temperatures, your Air Conditioner could fail. Dogs must always be on a leash, even at your campsite and are not permitted inside public buildings. Barking is not tolerated if your dog is bothering your neighbor's, you may be asked to leave or muzzle your pet. If your dog poops and no one is watching, you still need to pick it up
- **Speeding** -Please drive as fast as you can walk. Violators will be asked to park in the overflow parking lot and walk in the campground.
- Washrooms are to be respected and provided for personal hygiene tasks only.
- **Eneas Creek** flows through the campground, please do not dispose of any debris in the creek. The creek is not to be used for fishing or construction of anything that may cause a disruption in the flow.
- **No wood fires.** Propane fires are allowed, however cannot be left unattended and must be turned off by 11 p.m.
- **Generators** use is not recommended, however if required, use is restricted between 11 a.m. and 2 p.m.
- **Boats** are not permitted on your site. If you would like to keep your boat in the park, please purchase a site for your boat or park in the overflow parking lot across the street.
- **Pop/alcohol/juice** containers may be placed in small blue recycling bins in front of the washrooms.
- Pickle ball courts -9 a.m. to 9 p.m.
- Laundry facilities 8 a.m. 9.p.m.
- **Valuables** and coolers are to be kept inside your camping unit or vehicle: management is not responsible for theft or damage.
