



Change to Landfill Fees

The Summerland Landfill will be updating landfill fees starting **March 1, 2025**. Here are some of the changes:

MATERIAL TYPE	UPDATED FEE
Asphalt Shingles	\$ 65 per tonne
Carcasses	\$ 210 per tonne
Clean Soil	\$ 10 per tonne
Concrete with rebar	\$ 90 per tonne
Fibreglass and Preserved Wood	\$ 125 per tonne
Fruit Waste, Byproduct Fruit Grain	\$ 30 per tonne
Gypsum Wallboard (Drywall) verified not to contain asbestos	\$ 160 per tonne
Yard Waste / Green Wood	\$ 30 per tonne

Potential Asbestos Declaration form

To protect workers from exposure to asbestos, the Summerland Landfill will require customers to complete a Declaration form for any load that may include certain building materials that have the potential to contain asbestos. This requirement will be in effect **March 1, 2025**. Customers that do not comply with this requirement will face increased costs for disposal.

Building materials that will need to be declared:

- Gypsum wall board (drywall), wall tape, and drywall mud
- Plaster and plaster board
- Vinyl flooring and leveling compound
- Ceiling tiles
- Concrete pipe
- Stucco and concrete siding
- Attic insulation

As part of this Declaration form, any materials from structures built pre-1990 will require a WorkSafeBC clearance letter. A copy of the Declaration form is available online or by request at the Landfill.
